## Did you know....

The Canadian Mental Health Association (CHMA) is an organization dedicated to connecting people with the resources they need to improve mental health and recover from mental illness. In Canada, it is estimated that one in three people will experience a mental health problem in their lifetime. Essentially, it will affect each of us directly or indirectly at some point in our lives.

CHMA offers an informative course called **Mental Health First Aid**. It provides people with a basic understanding of mental health and the stigma that surrounds it. It teaches people how to recognize different symptoms of mental health problems, provide initial help and guide the person towards appropriate professional help. It touches upon four types of mental health disorders such as mood disorders, substance abuse disorders, anxiety and psychotic disorders.

Some people with an intellectual disability also experience a mental health disorder so it is important as friends, family and support staff to learn how to identify, respond and treat each symptom separately. How you provide day to day supports to someone may look different than when they are experiencing a mental health disorder.

Mental Health First Aid does not enable you to be a therapist but helps build awareness and can provide information on community resources.

It has been almost two years that *Options for Services* has been a permanent program of Innovative LIFE Options and we continue to serve a steady stream of ICOF participants and their support networks. I have enjoyed getting to know many new people as part of this position, and look forward to meeting many more. OFS has been an incredibly fun way to help people achieve their goals. From helping reduce the administrative load, to helping people get connected, or to getting to those things that always fall to the wayside... we just love to be creative in how we can be used! As always, finding skillful contractors is a main priority and we continue to advertise and screen in all areas of the province. I am proud to say that we now have fifteen contractors in our database; four in Brandon, one in Portage la Prairie, one in Altona, and nine in Winnipeg. I believe we have the strongest group of contractors to date and am very thankful for all of their hard and professional work. My aim is to develop small pockets of contractors in communities all around the province to provide the most accessible service possible. While we work toward that goal, OFS is still available to you even if there isn't a contractor in your community area. We believe that everyone should have access to this service and as such LIFE will cover the cost of travel to get our contractors out to you.

Last year OFS engaged in an exciting endeavor with Family Services and a family accessing self-managed respite dollars. We were approached to help the family set up a payroll system that met both their needs as well as the needs of Family Services. Its success has shown us that we can be helpful to individuals not receiving ICOF funding and we are exploring other possibilities. ICOF participants

will always remain our number one priority, but we are delighted that this service could be beneficial to a variety of populations.
